The Hard Teaching (v60-61)

- Jesus is the Bread of Life
- Jesus is the only Savior
- Jesus is in complete control
- Jesus used difficult language
- Jesus isn't afraid to offend

We need spiritual eyes and ears (v62-63)

- Our flesh is unable to appreciate the signs
- We need spiritual eyes to see the truth
- Jesus gives true spiritual life through his words

Jesus knows who are His (v64-66)

- Those who can't see won't believe
- There are true disciples and false disciples
- Only those given to Jesus by the Father are true
- False disciples turn their back on Jesus (1 John 2:19)

True disciples (v67-69)

- Jesus will ask if we want to stay with Him
- True disciples know there is nowhere else to go
- Only Jesus has Eternal Life

Jesus is Lord of All (v70-71)

- He alone chooses His disciples
- His plans are not our plans (Deuteronomy 29:29)
- God is sovereign over all
