S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29. T. 3. S. R. 7. E. Mt. Diablo Meridian and 20
chains North of the section line between Secs. 29 & 32 and
running thence with said U. S. meander line N. 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 15.82
chs - N. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 5.90 ch - to a post and mound at the inter-
section of E & W. line between the south half and the north half
of Sec. 29. thence on the same course 4.10 chs - N. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ °
W. 9 chs - N. 51 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W. 16.75 chs to a post and mound at
the intersection of E & W. line between the north half and
the south half of North East qr ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Sec. 29. thence west
10.85 chs - to a post on the right bank of the San Joa-
quin river, thence meander said river up stream on its
right bank, South 40° E. 2.85 chs - S. 43° E. 4.08 ch - S. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 15.00 ch -
