What if I do not have any experience?

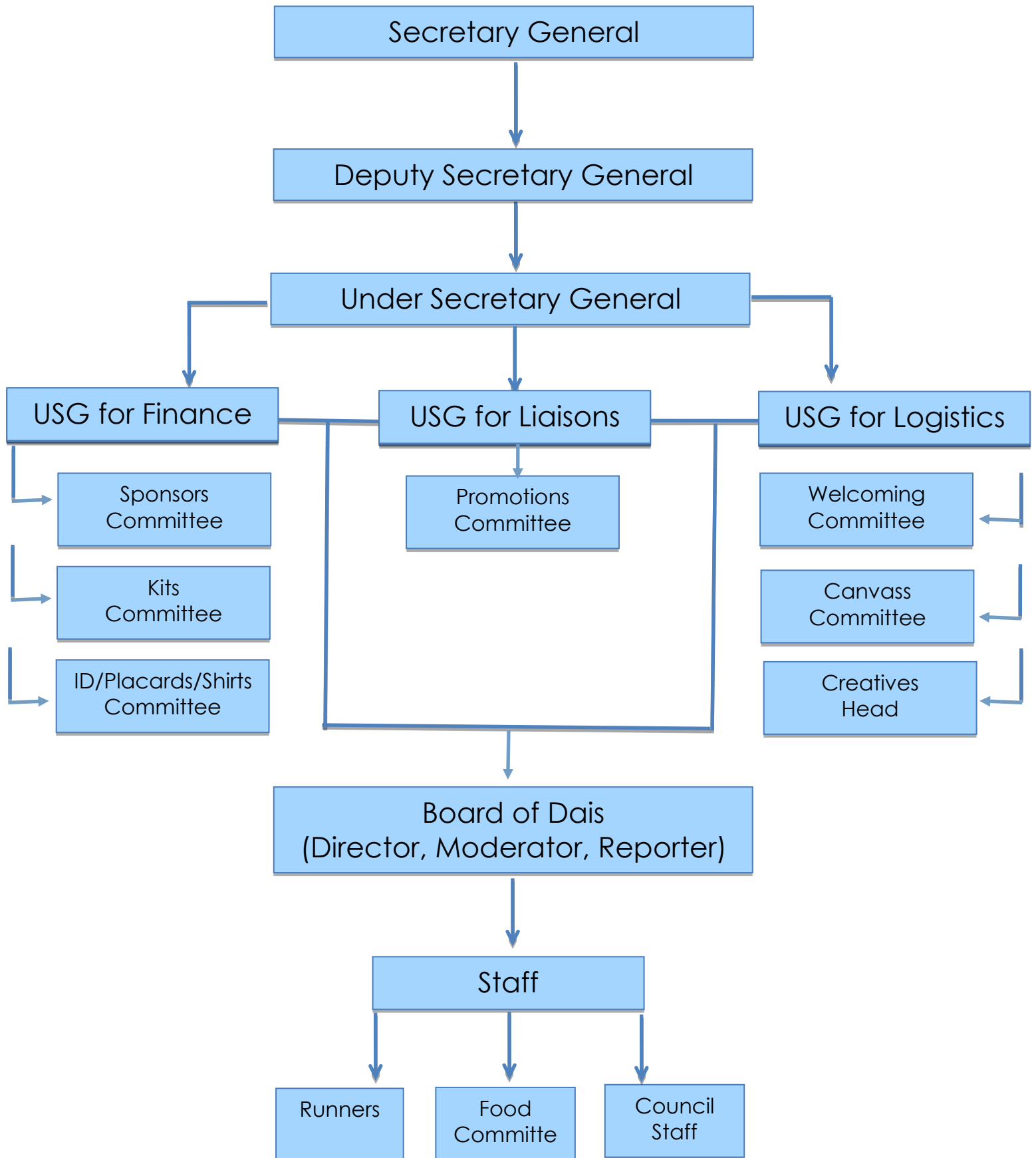

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Position	Role and Responsibility
<i>Under Secretary General for Finance</i>	He will be directed to the tasks of sponsorship, buying of the materials and all money related matters. Accordingly, budgeting and auditing for the event.
<i>Under Secretary General for Liaisons</i>	He will be the one assigned to handle the marketing and promotions. The paraphernalia will also be under his leadership. All information dissemination tasks will also be forwarded to him.
<i>Under Secretary General for Logistics</i>	He will be the one assigned to lead the delegate affairs before, during and after the event, be in charge of the staff by assigning them what to do as well as handling them well and other necessary manpower needed. He will also be assigned in canvassing for the materials needed in the event.
<i>Sponsors Committee</i>	They will be focused on reviewing and contacting sponsors for USTMUN 2017.
<i>Kits Committee</i>	They will be assigned to list the things that should be included inside each kit. They will also collect, organize, and distribute the kits.
<i>IDs/Placards/Shirts Committee</i>	They will be responsible in printing and organizing the IDs, Placards, and Shirts.

Promotions Committee	They will be strategize and head the promotions for USTMUN 2017.
Welcoming Committee	They will be in charge for the opening and closing of USTMUN 2017. Also, assigned to assists all international delegates.
Canvass Committee	They will canvass the materials that will be needed for USTMUN 2017
Creatives Head	He will be assigned in designing the publicity materials.
Director	He will be in charge of the assigned council and shall therefore oversee it. He will also be the one who will check the position papers and work hand in hand with the Moderator and Reporter to make the council. When issues arise, the director shall be the one assigned to make the necessary decisions for the council.
Moderator	He will be tasked to maintain the decorum during the sessions and shall work as the speaker of the board of dais. He will be assigned to moderate and keep the council in order at all times.

Reporter	He will be the one assigned in monitoring the happenings during the sessions and is in charge of timing and writing down relevant notes to the topics. He will also be reporting to the Secretary General on a daily basis during the committee session.
Runners	They are expected to be present in the duration of the event and whenever they are needed.
Food Committee	They are in charge for the snacks, lunch, coffee break, and dinner for USTMUN 21017.
Council Staff	They will be tasked to assist the Board of Dais in whichever council they are assigned and will pass the notes the delegates wish to send.

COUNCILS

The General Assembly (GA) is the main deliberative, policymaking and representative organ of the UN. Decisions on important questions, such as

those on peace and security, admission of new members and budgetary matters, require a two-thirds majority. Decisions on other questions are by simple majority.

The Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) is the principal body for coordination, policy review, policy dialogue and recommendations on economic, social and environmental issues, as well as for implementation of the internationally agreed development goals.

The Security Council (SC) takes the lead in determining the existence of a threat to the peace or act of aggression. It calls upon the parties to a dispute to settle it by peaceful means and recommends methods of adjustment or terms of settlement. In some cases, the Security Council can resort to imposing sanctions or even authorize the use of force to maintain or restore international peace and security.
